LAND DRAINAGE, ENGLAND AND WALES.
River Ouse (Yorks.) Catchment Board.

THE RIVER OUSE (YORKS.) CATCHMENT BOARD (DEMPSTER INTERNAL DRAINAGE DISTRICT) ORDER, 1932, CONFIRMED APRIL 29, 1932, BY THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES, UNDER THE LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930 (20 & 21 GEO. 5. c. 44).

Whereas the Scheme confirmed by the River Ouse (Yorks.) Catchment Board (Dempster Internal Drainage District) Order, 1932, provides that the appointed day therein mentioned shall be a day to be appointed by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries.

Now therefore the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby orders that the said appointed day shall be the second day of May, nineteen hundred and thirty-two.

In witness whereof the Official Seal of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries is hereunto affixed this twentieth day of April, nineteen hundred and thirty-two.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

River Ouse (Yorks.) Catchment Board.

(1) The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Land Drainage Act, 1930, and of every other power in that behalf, hereby confirms the Scheme in relation to the Dempster Internal Drainage District, submitted to him by the River Ouse (Yorks.) Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of the said Act and annexed hereto: with the following amendments which have been incorporated in the scheme:—

(a) *Paragraph 1.*—The words "As from the first day of December, 1931" have been deleted, and the words "As from a day to be appointed by the Minister" substituted therefor.

(b) *Paragraph 2 (b).*—The date to which the members of the first Internal Drainage Board shall hold office has been amended to the first day of November, 1933.

In witness whereof the Official Seal of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries is hereunto affixed this seventeenth day of March, nineteen hundred and thirty-two.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

River Ouse (Yorks.) Catchment Board.

The River Ouse (Yorks.) Catchment Board, in pursuance of Sub-section 1 (b) of Section 4 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, have prepared the following scheme making provision for certain matters mentioned in the said sub-section, namely:—

The amendment of the method of constituting the Drainage Area Committee for the Dempster Drainage Area constituted under the West Riding of Yorkshire County Council (Drainage) Act, 1923,^(a) so as to secure that the members

thereof shall be persons elected as such members in accordance with the provisions in that behalf contained in Part V of the Land Drainage Act, 1930.

And the Catchment Board submit the scheme to the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries for confirmation under section 4 of the said Act.

Scheme.

1. As from a day to be appointed by the Minister the provisions of the West Riding of Yorkshire County Council (Drainage) Act, 1923, respecting the appointment of members of the Drainage Area Committee for the Dempster Drainage Area constituted by Order of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries dated the twenty-fourth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, shall no longer apply and the members of the said Drainage Area Committee (herein referred to as "The Internal Drainage Board") shall be persons elected as such members in accordance with the provisions in that behalf contained in Section 33 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930.

2.—(a) The Internal Drainage Board shall be styled "The Dempster Internal Drainage Board" and shall consist of seven members.

(b) The following persons shall be members of the first Internal Drainage Board and shall hold office until the first day of November, 1933, viz. :—

Messrs. Lewis Sydney Chantry, Dutch River Side, Goole;
William Edward Chantry, Bridge Farm, Bridge Street,
Goole; Henry Firth, Decoy Farm, Dutch River Side, Goole;
William Hinchcliff, Belvedere, Thorne Road, Doncaster;
William Temple Lipscomb, Estate Office, Bramham, Boston
Spa, Yorks; Leslie Smith, North House, High Street, Snaith,
Near Goole, and Richard Liddle Walker, Boothferry House,
Near Goole.

3. Property, rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities vested in or to be discharged by the said Drainage Area Committee in relation to the Area or by the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire shall be vested in or discharged by the Internal Drainage Board.

4. The expenses of the Minister and such expenses as shall be certified by him to have been reasonably incurred by the Catchment Board in relation to the preparation and making of this Order, shall be a first charge on the rates levied by the Internal Drainage Board.
